

1 **ORDINANCE NO. 973**

2 **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 899, AND 28 TO DEFINE THE NOTICE**
3 **PROCEDURE, TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY, AND COST OF**
4 **REMOVAL OF UNLAWFULLY DEPOSITED SNOW, ICE AND SLUSH THEREBY**
5 **AMENDING SEC. 17-24 (c) and (d) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF**
6 **GLASGOW, MONTANA**

6 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Glasgow, Montana:

7 That Ordinance No. 899 and Ordinance No. 28 be amended by enactment of the following
8 provisions:

10 **Sec. 17-24. Violations, work by city, penalties, collection.**

11 ...

12 **(c) Notice Procedure.**

12 (1) Written notice of violation shall provide at a minimum:

- 13 (a) The director of public works shall keep a record of the exact date of all work caused
14 to be done in accordance with this section on account of the act or omission of each
15 person;
- 16 (b) Name and address of the owner in violation of section 17-22 and 17-23 of this chap-
17 ter;
- 18 (c) All owners of real property are responsible for removal of snow not later than Sep-
19 tember 30th of each year and are responsible for keeping the areas free of snow
20 through April 30th of that year;
- 18 (d) Failure to remove the snow within twenty-four (24) hours will result in the city re-
19 moving the snow and charging the owner costs of removal;
- 19 (e) Owner will receive only one violation notice per season, and the city will remove the
20 snow as needed without any additional notice to the owner. Owner bears the cost of
21 all snow removal performed by the city.

21 (2) Written notice of violation shall be served in the following manner:

- 22 (a) If the subject property is occupied by the owner, notice shall be either personally
23 served on such owner or mailed to such owner at the owner's last known address, by
24 first class United States mail;
- 25 (b) If the subject property is not occupied by the owner, notice shall be mailed to the
26 owner at the owner's last known address, by first class United States mail;
- 27 (c) Such notice shall be deemed complete on the day of personal service or on the day
28 such notice is deposited in any United States post office.

1 (d) ***Cost of Removal.***

2 (1) The cost for removal is as follows:

- 3 (a) First time violation, two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for the city providing removal of
4 snow.
5 (b) Second time violation, three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for the city providing removal
6 of snow.
7 (c) Third time violation, four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for the city providing removal of
8 snow.
9 (d) On continued offences, the penalty will increase one hundred dollars, for a maximum
10 fine of five-hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the city to provide the removal of snow.
11 (e) All of which will be charged to the owner of the subject property by mailing a bill or
12 statement to the owner at the owner's last known address.

13 **Repealer**

14 All resolutions, ordinances and sections of the Municipal Code and parts thereof in conflict
15 herewith are hereby repealed.

16 **Severability**

17 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance is for any reason
18 held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remain-
19 ing portions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordi-
20 nance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, and words thereof irrespective
21 of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or words
22 have been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if for any reason any provision of this ordi-
23 nance should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the remaining ordinance provision
24 will be in full force and effect.

25 **Effective Date**

26 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after passage on second reading.

27 **Editor**

28 Editor to re-arrange Chapter. The Editor, Municipal Code Corporation, is hereby authorized to
re-number and re-arrange Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Glasgow, as in
its discretion it deems appropriate.
