

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18-41 OF ORDINANCE NO. 900 TO
RECOGNIZE THE ADDITION OF OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND
CLARIFY THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF IN THE CITY LIMITS OF GLASGOW,
MONTANA, AND THEREBY AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF
THE CITY OF GLASGOW, MONTANA**

WHEREAS, the City has installed additional signage and traffic control devices in accordance with the requirements of the City of Glasgow and the Montana Department of Transportation.

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 900 be amended as follows:

All traffic control devices, including signs, signals, markings, parking spaces, and devices not inconsistent with this chapter, in existence on the date ordinance no. _____ becomes effective [_____], are declared to be “official traffic control devices” and are enforceable. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provision or to fail to comply with any requirement of this chapter.

Section 2: All resolutions, ordinances and sections of the Municipal Code and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Ordinance No. 900, amended by this ordinance, shall remain in force to authorize the arrest, prosecution, conviction and punishment of a person who violates Ordinance No. 900 prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after final passage and approval.

Section 5: Editor to re-arrange Chapter. The Editor, Municipal Code Corporation, is hereby authorized to replace Chapter 18, Section 18-42 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Glasgow.
